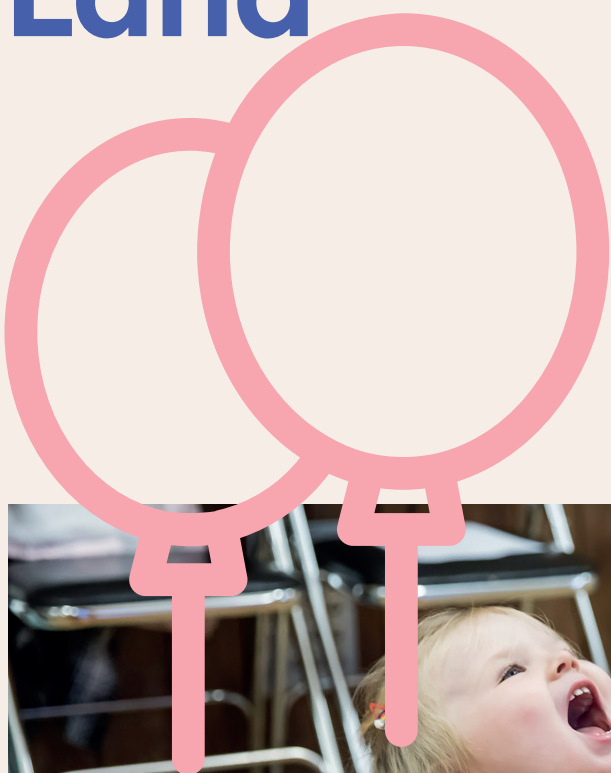


Fantasy Land

Useful things to collect:

Silver tinfoil
Paper/pens/paint/sticky tape
Cardboard boxes
Blankets/sheets/cushions
Pans/bowls/plastic cups
Plain flour
Balloons
Old toothbrush
Old newspapers/magazines
Sticks, leaves, feathers
Sponge/shower scrunchie
String/wool

Top tips for adults:

- Encourage your child to help you find natural objects outside that can be used as part of their play.
- Think about any songs/rhymes that you may know about fairy tales, princesses, knights, or dragons e.g. (To the tune of 'Five Little Ducks went Swimming One Day')

'Five little dragons went out to play, Over the hills and far away; Mother dragon said, "It's time for snack!" But only four little dragons came back. Three/Two/One/No little dragons came back. Worried Mother dragon began to breathe fire, But the tears she shed made the fire expire; Mother dragon said, "It's a really good snack." And all five little dragons came back!'

(To the tune of 'Frere Jacques')

'Brave, brave knight (x2) With your sword (x2) Wearing lots of armour, You deserve a reward!' (x2)

Ideas to explore in Fantasy Land:

- Be a king or queen for a day. What would you do? What rules would you have in your kingdom?
- Make a castle or fort out of cushions, blankets, and stable furniture.
- Make a dragon's egg, maybe a balloon filled with water, and make an outside obstacle course to carry it across. Start at the 'woods' and carefully get it back to the 'nest'. You could make a nest using sticks, leaves, and feathers to carefully place your egg at the end.
- Build a tall tower using boxes, plastic cups, or old lids. Roll or throw a sponge, shower scrunchie or soft ball and see if you can knock down your tower!
- Try making different sounds with your voice and body to create noises in your world - like dragons stomping or sword swishes.
- Use long thin balloons to have a pretend sword fight with a dragon.
- Make a maze using string, a ball of wool or rolled up towels. Place different objects, e.g. small toys, buttons, pebbles, feathers in the maze. Find a way in to collect them.
- Draw some 'dragon teeth' and cover with sticky tape. Use felt tip pens to cover the teeth with spots and lines. Think about how you should keep your teeth healthy and help the dragon by brushing its teeth clean with a toothbrush.
- Make a life-size knight's shield from a large cardboard box and cover it in paint or tinfoil.
